Moonshot Academy (MSA)



Goal: to increase student achievement, close learning gaps, and develop a love of reading through authentic learning experiences.



Virtual Moonshot Academy Structure

Duration: 4 weeks, 5 days/week, 2-3 hours/day

Schedule:

Whole Group Class (45-60 min)

- Moonshot Mindful Routine
- Engaging reading and writing activities

Tutoring Time (45 min)

Foundational Literacy: Intervention

Enrichment Class (60 min)

Led by community partners



Virtual Moonshot Academy Structure

Whole Group Class	Daily, 45-60 min, 1:4 Ratio
Tutoring Time	Daily, 45 min, 1:1
Enrichment Class	Tuesday and Thursdays, 60 min, 1:12-16












Preparation: Keys to Success


- Adjusted curriculum to be delivered virtually








CORE Phonics Survey Pre/Post - 1st Grade






CORE Phonics Survey Pre/Post- 2nd Grade




First Grade Weekly Vocabulary Assessment - MSA Virtual Summer 2020




Vocabulary scores grew on average from 31% to 91% in 4 weeks.

Content Vocabulary Pre and Post Assessment 2nd and 3rd Grade - MSA Virtual Summer 2020






Oral Reading Fluency - MSA Virtual Summer



2nd grade grew ORF by 13 words in 4 weeks and 3rd Grade grew 9 words. Both exceeded expected growth.

Average Dosage by School



Target dosage for 1:1 Tutoring is 3.75 hrs per week. Target dosage for Whole Group is 5 hrs per week.

Teacher Reflections

I used to think that teaching virtual was difficult but now I think with right support anything is possible. It definitely took me out of my comfort zone and pushed me to try something new.
